Background



NEED

Adolescent Girls and Young Women (AGYW) ages 15-24 account for 68 per cent of young people in Eastern and Southern Africa (ESA) who are living with HIV.



CHALLENGE

The success of PrEP as an HIV prevention intervention among AGYW is dependent on its successful uptake and adherence by AGYW.



OPPORTUNITY

As countries are moving forward with PrEP implementation for AGYW, more understanding and guidance is needed to successfully implement PrEP programs for AGYW.

Aims and Objectives

The aim of the regional think tank and webinar series is to inform quality implementation and scale-up of PrEP Programming for AGYW in the ESA region as part of combination HIV prevention interventions.
